GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Montague qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet in the Turners Falls High School Theater on Saturday, May 5, 2012, at 8:30 A.M. and to act on the following articles and any motions which may be presented.

**ARTICLE 1.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide the sum of \$30,000 or any other amount, for the purpose of restoring 38 Avenue A through remediation and roof repair or demolition of the building, or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

**ARTICLE 2.** To see if the Town will vote to accept a donation of the St. Anne's Rectory, 25 Sixth Street, Turners Falls, (Map 03, Lot 022) or pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.

**ARTICLE 3.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide the sum of \$1,910.00 or any other amount, for the purpose of purchasing flags and accessories to be installed throughout the Town of Montague, or to pass any vote or votes in relations thereto.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof in some conspicuous place in each of the Post Offices, Libraries, and Town Hall of the Town, at least fourteen days before said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this document with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk fourteen days before said meeting.
